## Interesting stops on the South Shore

### Exit 7 Chester

- A pleasant stop for food and shopping, with great views



### Exit 10 Mahone Bay

- Another excellent stop for lunch and shopping - check out the famous three churches

### Exit 11 Lunenburg

- It's 11 km from the exit to the World Heritage Site - worth the trip for the sights and attractions

### Exit 15 Italy Cross

- Petite Riviere Wine Shop (6.5 km from the exit, open weekends)

### Exit 19 Liverpool

- Hank Snow Museum - a tribute to the famous country singer (open Friday, not Sunday)



- Rossignol Centre - Wildlife Museum, Folk Art Museum and Museum of the Outhouse! Liverpool Library is in the same building.

### Exit 20 Summerville Centre

- White Point Lodge - site of the 2010 NSLA/LBANS conference



### Route 103 Port Joli

- If you feel like a long hike, check out the Keji Seaside Adjunct (St. Catherine's Rd.) or Thomas Raddall Provincial Park (Port l'Hebert Rd.)
- Or take a short walk at the Pocket Wilderness near Sable River



### Exit 23 Sable River

- Take the Lockeport Loop on Rte. 3 to see the famous Crescent Beach

### Exit 25 or 26 Shelburne



- See Shelburne Harbour and the location for the movie The Scarlet Letter by taking a walk or a drive along Dock Street

### Exit 30 Barrington

- You can take this exit to Rte. 3 for a scenic drive through fishing villages like Shag Harbour (location of the UFO sighting in 1967)



### Exit 31 West Pubnico

- Musé Acadien (5 km on Rte. 335) An excellent community museum.
- Pubnico Point Wind Farm (End of Rte. 335) See the 17 windmills up close

### Exit 7 Chester

- Village Emporium - gifts and crafts (Pleasant Street)
- Hibiscus - fashion and accessories (Queen Street)

### Exit 10 Mahone Bay

- Mahone Bay Trading Co - biggest distributor of Clark Shoes east of Montreal! (Main Street)
- Amos Pewter (Main Street)
- The Old Station - home of P'lovers Environmental Store and Scotian Ocean Artisan Market (Edgewater Street)

### Exit 12 Bridgewater

- Guy's Frenchy's (North Street)
- Turn right for Walmart, Canadian Tire

### Exit 13 Wileville

- Wiles Lake Farm Market and Bakery (turn right, 3 km on Rte 325)

On the 103 just down the road from Exit 14

- Bob and the Boys Farm Market - gifts, fruit and vegetables and ice cream

### Exit 19 Liverpool

- Woodpile Carvings and Café - handcarvings and lunch too

### Exit 26 Shelburne

- Charlotte Lane Café has a great gift shop
- Spencer's Garden Centre - off Exit 26

### Exit 7 Chester

- Julien's Pastry Shop
- Kiwi Café (Pleasant St.)

### Exit 10 Mahone Bay

- Biscuit Eater Café and Books (Orchard St.)
- Salt Spray Café & Chowder House (Main St.)

### Exit 11 Blockhouse

- Happy Cooker - look for the Restaurant sign on the red roof just off the exit

### Exit 12 Bridgewater

- Turn right for Boston Pizza and Swiss Chalet, left for A&W and the Petro Canada diner (recommended)

### Exit 14 Hebbs Cross

- Blarney Stone Restaurant - a traditional stop for travelers on the South Shore

### Exit 19 Liverpool

- Lane's Privateer Inn - by the river

### Exit 20 Summerville Centre

- Seaside Seafoods - on Rte. 3, world's best clams and seafood chowder

### Exit 26 Shelburne

- Charlotte Lane Café - award-winning restaurant
- Lothars (German food).

### Exit 31 Pubnico

- Red Cap Diner - 5 km on Rte. 335, an Acadian institution, great seafood

## Interesting Stops through the Valley



### Exit 10 Grand Pre

- Domaine de Grand Pre Winery Tour

### Exit 11 Wolfville

- Acadia University (especially the Harriet Irving Botanical Gardens)



### Exit 12 New Minas

- Pumpkin People! Drive through Kentville to see lots of pumpkin people, especially around the Agricultural Research Centre

### Exit 16 Aylesford

- Oak Lawn Zoo

### Exit 22 Annapolis Royal

- Annapolis Tidal Power Dam (8 km from exit)
- Annapolis Royal Historic Gardens

### Route 101 Plympton

(between Digby and Weymouth)

- Savary Park - beautiful view and a great place to stretch your legs.

### Route 101 Gilbert's Cove

(just after Plympton)

- Gilbert's Cove lighthouse - turn right off the 101 for a great view of St. Mary's Bay

### Exit 27 Weymouth

- Take the Weymouth Loop to see a picturesque village set among rolling hills. Check out Sissiboo Landing Interpretive Centre beside the river.



- Church Point - campus of Université Ste. Anne and Église Sainte-Marie (largest wooden church in North America)

- Meteghan - check out the wharf, one of the largest in the province. And the Jerome Monument (beside Stella Maris Church)

- Meteghan - Smugglers Cove Provincial Park - dramatic cliffs

- Mavillette - turn right at John Doucette Road for a view of the dunes and sand of Mavillette Beach and the picture-perfect fishing village of Cape St. Mary



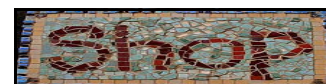
### Exit 28 St. Bernard

*Explore the Acadian District of Clare via Route 1*

- Église St. Bernard - stone church that seats 1010 people

- Frenchys (a big one on the way into town)
- Happy Harry's (just before Frenchys)

### St. Bernard (Exit 28)

- Frenchys (turn left)

- Jackie's (turn right) used clothing

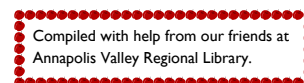
### Saulnierville (Route 1)

- Smitty's - used clothing (left at Saulnier Road)

- Clarence's Shopping Mart - great place for everything from groceries to craft supplies to shoes

### Meteghan Centre (Route 1)

- Frenchys (182 Rte. 1) considered one of the best



### Exit 10 Grand Pre

- Just Us - great place for a latte or some chocolate

### Exit 11 Wolfville

- Paddy's Pub for good pub food; or Actons, Blomidon Inn or Tempest (Front St.) for a gourmet spurge.

### Exit 12 New Minas

- Irving Big Stop and Smitty's just off the exit.

### Exit 15 Berwick

- Union Street Café (183 Commercial St.) - a good place for lunch or pie

### Exit 17E Kingston

- Marie and Guy's French Bakery (690 Main St. next to Pharmasave) - chocolate croissants to die for!

### Exit 22 Annapolis Royal

- Ye Old Towne Pub (11 Church St.)

- Leo's Café (St. George St.) - great soup and sandwiches

### Exit 26 Digby

- Irving Big Stop - gas and grub just off the 101

### Route 1 Belliveau's Cove

- Roadside Grill for rappie pie or clams and chips,
- Chez Christophe in Grosses-Coques - an authentic Acadian experience.
