



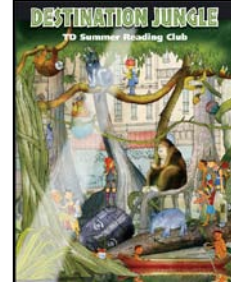

Tuesday, Aug. 6, 3 to 4 p.m.

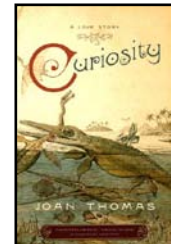

Saturday, Sept. 25, 12:30 to 2 p.m.

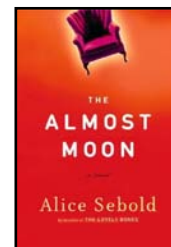
